

Please correct the following statements that were attributed to me. They are incorrect in the August 13, 2003 minutes.

1. There was one addition, one correction and one clarification of the previous minutes that were agreed to and are not in the minutes.

Minutes: Linda Caley gave the Chairman a list of “corrections” to the minutes. Mary Weinman clarified that the minutes were actually what was “discussed” by the group at the July 21 meeting. This statement is not correct. Each requested correction was read and addressed as follows.

Linda Caley made the following requests for corrections.

1 **Addition** The commissioner reiterated several times that Abuse of Private *Property by Park Users will not be Tolerated*). **Mary Weinman agreed that the Commissioner had stated that and it needed to be added to the minutes.**

2. **Correction to the statement:** The consensus received during the surveying for the Master Plan was that 50-150 foot buffers would be sufficient. Linda Caley requested clarification of this statement since the Master Plan actually states that all setback distances would be agreed upon under future detailed design standards by appropriate county officials, adjacent landowners and park steering committee. **Mary Weinman clarified that the minutes were actually what was “discussed” by the group at the July 21 meeting not a final decision. .**

3. **Correction to the statement** the possibility of fencing or other screening where adequate setbacks could not be achieved. **to reflect that the Commissioner specifically said that he would put a fence up if Mr. Corsi or any other landowner actually had a problem. Mary Weinman stated that the commissioner did not say that he said that he would consider it.**

4. **Correction to the Addition to Agenda :** Proposed formation of steering committee for Friends of Hunters Creek. Suggested: 2 representatives from each group for a total of 11. (2 bikers, 2 adjacent property owners, 2 equestrians, 2 hikers, 2 county personnel and Chairperson). **Mary Weinman agreed that that the exact makeup of the steering committee for Hunters creek was outlined in the Master Plan and that is what will be used.**

2. **The statement attributed to me about the closing the buffer zone on the north boundary is not at all true. The statement currently says: Proposal for stabilization and maintenance of buffer zone:** Linda Caley reports that the “concerned neighbors” have arraigned for 15 volunteers to close the buffer zone on the Northwest boundary of

HC. They will present their closure plans at the next meeting for approval by the County.

Correction to this statement: This is the statement I made: Proposal for stabilization and maintenance of buffer zone: Linda Caley reported that this is a high priority for the Concerned Property Owners for Hunters Creek. We met and reviewed the Trail consultants report and the Master Plan and decided that stabilization and maintenance will involve more than trail closure. We currently have at least 15 volunteers who are willing to work on this. We are in the process of putting together a proposal for presentation at the September meeting
